**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF
ARCO PERMIAN TO SUSPEND THE ALLOCATION FORMULA
FOR THE WILSHIRE (CONSOLIDATED) FIELD
UPTON COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on November 3, 1999, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of ARCO Permian for suspension of the allocation formula in the Wilshire (Consolidated) Field be and is hereby approved. The allocation formula is hereby suspended effective the date this order is signed. Any reinstatement of the allocation formula at a future date shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of Statewide Rule 31(j)(3), if the market demand for gas in the Wilshire (Consolidated) Field drops below 100% of deliverability, without the necessity for a hearing. The Wilshire (Consolidated) Field will be balanced effective the day this order is signed.
