**RE: THE APPLICATION OF DOMINION
OKLAHOMA TEXAS E&P, INC. TO
SUSPEND THE ALLOCATION
FORMULA IN THE GIT MO (MORROW)
FIELD, HEMPHILL COUNTY, TEXAS**

FINAL ORDER

After statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on June 13, 2006, the Railroad Commission of Texas makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Notice of at least ten (10) days was given to all operators in the field and no one appeared at the hearing in protest.
2. The Git Mo (Morrow) Field is a non-associated field which was discovered in 1985. There are three wells in the field, one operated by BP America Production Company, one operated by Brighton Energy, LLC and one operated by Dominion Oklahoma Texas E&P, Inc.
3. All operators of producing wells in the subject field have 100% market demand for the gas produced from wells under their control.
 - a. BP America Production Company and Dominion Oklahoma Texas E&P, Inc. executed Form AOF-2 for the subject field.
 - b. Brighton Energy, LLC did not execute Form AOF-2 but did not protest the application.
 - c. Dominion's investigation of market conditions in the field did not reveal any curtailments of production due to lack of market.
 - d. Brighton's gatherer is Enbridge Pipeline, which is the same as Dominion. Dominion submitted a letter from Enbridge Pipeline indicating a market for 100% of the gas produced from the field.
4. Suspension of the allocation formula in the Git Mo (Morrow) Field will not cause a pipeline limitation.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Proper notice was issued by the Railroad Commission of Texas to persons legally entitled to notice.
2. All things have been done and occurred to give the Railroad Commission of Texas jurisdiction to decide this matter.
3. The subject field meets all the criteria established for suspension of the allocation formula under Statewide Rule 31(j).

Therefore, it is ORDERED by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of Dominion Oklahoma Texas E&P, Inc. for suspension of the allocation formula in the Git Mo (Morrow) Field is approved. The allocation formula may be reinstated administratively if the market demand for gas in the Git Mo (Morrow) Field drops below 100% of deliverability. If the market demand for gas in the Git Mo (Morrow) Field drops below 100% of deliverability while the allocation formula is suspended, the operator shall immediately notify the Commission and the allocation formula shall be immediately reinstated.
