ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR REHEARING

The Commission has considered on its merits the Motion for Rehearing filed by Devon Energy Production Co. LP, on December 1, 2008, and the Motion is granted for the limited purposes of amending certain findings of fact, conclusions of law and the final order paragraph adopted in the Final Order served November 12, 2008, as set forth herein, and amending the designated interval description.

It is accordingly ORDERED that Findings of Fact No. 1, Conclusions of Law Nos. 3 and 4 and the final order paragraph adopted in the Final Order served November 12, 2008, are amended as set forth below, and, as amended, are adopted. Except to the extent amended herein, findings of fact and conclusions of law adopted in the Final Order served November 12, 2008, are affirmed.

AMENDED FINDINGS OF FACT NO. 1

1. Devon Energy Production Co. LP (P-5 Operator No. 216378) requests a Railroad Commission of Texas certification that the wells completed in the formation comprising the Bend Conglomerate correlative interval in Cooke, Denton, Parker, Tarrant and Wise Counties, Texas, are completed in a high-cost/tight-gas formation pursuant to Statewide Rule 101.

AMENDED CONCLUSIONS OF LAW NO. 3

3. The proposed portions of the Bend Conglomerate correlative interval, including the Boonsville (Bend Cong., Gas) Field (Field No. 10574-520) and other Commission designated fields within Cooke, Denton, Parker, Tarrant and Wise Counties, Texas, comply with the provisions of 16 TAC §3.101(f)(3)(B) and the Commission determines that wells completed in the subject formation within said area are producing from a high cost/tight gas formation.

AMENDED CONCLUSIONS OF LAW NO. 4

4. Gas produced from wells completed in the Bend Conglomerate correlative interval located within Cooke, Denton, Parker, Tarrant and Wise Counties, Texas, is a high cost/tight formation gas pursuant to 16 TAC §3.101.

AMENDED ORDER PARAGRAPH

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that effective November 12, 2008, the application of Devon Energy Production Co. LP for the Commission's certification that the Bend Conglomerate formation recognized and identified as that section found in the interval between the base of the Caddo Lime and the top of the Marble Falls formations within Cooke, Denton, Parker, Tarrant and Wise Counties, Texas, as shown in the attached Exhibit 1A, including the Boonsville (Bend Cong., Gas) Field (Field No. 10574-520) and other Commission designated fields within that interval in these counties, be designated a tight gas formation and therefore produces high cost gas pursuant to 16 TAC §3.101, be and is hereby approved.

It is further **ORDERED** that except to the extent granted herein, the Motion for Rehearing is **DENIED**.
