COMMISSION CALLED HEARING ON THE COMPLAINT OF WOOLSEY WELL SERVICE, L.P. AND J & C OPERATING CO. REGARDING THE VALIDITY OF THE PERMITS ISSUED FOR RSK-STAR LEASE, WELL NOS. 5 AND 6, NEWARK, E. (BARNETT SHALE) FIELD, WISE COUNTY, TEXAS .

FINAL ORDER

The Commission finds that a hearing in the captioned proceeding was heard by the examiners on October 31, 2006 who have circulated a Proposal for Decision containing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law. Having been duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas, those Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law are hereby adopted and made a part hereof by reference.

It is accordingly **ORDERED** that the complaint of Woolsey Well Service, L.P. and J & C Operating Co. regarding the validity of the permits issued for RSK-Star Lease, Well Nos. 5 and 6, Newark, E. (Barnett Shale) Field, Wise County, Texas is hereby **DISMISSED**.

It is further **ORDERED** by the Commission that this order shall not be final and effective until 20 days after a party is notified of the Commission's order. A party is presumed to have been notified of the Commission's order 3 days after the date on which the notice is actually mailed. If a timely motion for rehearing is filed by any party at interest within such 20-day period after the party's presumed notice, this order shall not become final until such motion is overruled, or if rehearing is granted, this order shall be subject to further action by the Commission. Pursuant to TEX. GOV'T CODE § 2001.146(e), the time allotted for Commission action on a motion for rehearing in this case prior to its being overruled by operation of law, is hereby extended until 90 days from the date the parties are notified of the order in accordance with TEX. GOV'T CODE §2001.144.

Each exception to the examiners' proposal for decision not expressly granted herein is overruled. All requested findings of fact and conclusions of law which are not expressly adopted herein are denied. All pending motions and requests for relief not previously granted or granted herein are denied.
