**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF
ENERQUEST OPERATING, LLC
FOR EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULES 7 & 13
FOR ITS BAKER UNIT, WELL NO. 2H
DUBOSE (EDWARDS-A-) FIELD
GONZALES COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on January 13, 2012, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and proposal for decision, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Enerquest Operating, LLC is found compliant with Statewide Rule 7 and is hereby granted exception to Statewide Rule 13 for its Baker Unit Well No. 2H (API # 177-32051) in the Dubose (Edwards-A-) Field, Gonzales County. Enerquest Operating, LLC is not required to perform a remedial cement operation to comply with Statewide Rule 13(b)(4)(A) for the wellbore. The well may be assigned an allowable, assuming all other required completion papers have been properly filed.

It is further ordered that all overproduction for the subject well is hereby canceled.
