**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF
STAR PRODUCTION, INC.
TO EXPAND THE CORRELATIVE INTERVAL
FOR THE STAR LIGHT (PALO PINTO) FIELD
TOM GREEN COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on August 10, 2006, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of Star Production, Inc. to expand the designated interval of the Star Light (Palo Pinto) Field to the correlative interval from 2642 feet to 2780 feet as shown on the reservoir saturation-gamma ray log of the Star Production, Inc., Matschek Unit Well No. 1, Section 1657-B, Kramer Survey, Tom Green County, Texas.
