**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF CONOCOPHILLIPS COMPANY
FOR AUTHORITY PURSUANT TO STATEWIDE RULE 23(a)(2)
FOR ITS TEXAS HUGOTON GAS UNIT 16, WELL NO. 1R
TEXAS HUGOTON FIELD
SHERMAN COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on February 20, 2009, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that ConocoPhillips Company is hereby granted authority pursuant to Statewide Rule 23(a)(2) for its Texas Hugoton Gas Unit 16, Well No. 1R (Gas I.D. No. 10-200955) in the Texas Hugoton Field in Sherman County, Texas.

This approval is limited to a maximum of 20 inches of mercury vacuum.
