FINAL ORDER

The Commission finds that, after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket, heard on March 24, 2004, the examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, which was served on all parties of record, and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation and the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

D. Laird Survey, A-1669 and J. H. Suttles Survey, A-1660 in Harris County, Texas, be and is hereby **APPROVED**.
