**APPLICATION OF KATY MILLS RESIDUAL LIMITED
PARTNERSHIP TO CONSIDER APPROVAL OF A
QUALIFIED SUBDIVISION PURSUANT TO STATEWIDE
RULE 76 IN HARRIS COUNTY, TEXAS.**

FINAL ORDER

The Commission finds that, after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket, heard on October 31, 2007, the examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, which was served on all parties of record, and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation and the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of Katy Mills Residual Limited Partnership to consider approval of a qualified subdivision pursuant to Statewide Rule 76 for a 16.1515 acre tract subdivision as identified on the subdivision plat attached as Exhibit 1 to this Final Order, located within the the J.W. McCutcheon Survey, Section 44, A-1348, in Harris County, Texas, be and is hereby **APPROVED**. Legal descriptions of the subdivision and the drill site operations area are attached to this Final Order as Exhibits 2 and 3.
