**APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF VASTAR RESOURCES INC.
FOR INCREASED GAS-OIL RATIO FOR THE G.T. ALLISON OIL UNIT
WELL NO. 11-U, CARTHAGE (TRAVIS PEAK) FIELD, PANOLA COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on June 1, 2000, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Vastar Resources Inc. is hereby granted permission to produce the G.T. Allison Oil Unit Well No. 11-U, Carthage (Travis Peak) Field, Panola County, Texas, under increased gas-oil ratio authority which results in a casinghead gas limit of 750 MCF of gas per day. It is further ordered the subject well is granted a special allowable of 111 barrels of oil per day. Further, it is effective the date of this order that all casinghead gas and oil production is hereby canceled.
