**FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF MITCHELL ENERGY CORPORATION  
FOR INCREASED GAS-OIL RATIO AUTHORITY  
LAKE CREEK (WILCOX CONSOLIDATED) FIELD  
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on May 17, 2000, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of Mitchell Energy Corporation be and is hereby granted such that each well in the Lake Creek (Wilcox Consolidated) Field, Montgomery County, Texas, may produce under unlimited gas-oil ratio authority without a gas limit.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction for the wells in the Lake Creek (Wilcox Consolidated) Field, Montgomery County, be and is hereby canceled as of the date of this order.
