**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF HAMMON OIL & REFINING COMPANY
FOR INCREASED GAS-OIL RATIO AUTHORITY
FOR ITS CALDWELL -26- LEASE WELL NOS. 3 AND 4
CREDO, E. (CISCO, UP.) FIELD
STERLING COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on September 1, 2000, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Hammon Oil & Refining Company be and is hereby granted permission to produce its Caldwell -26- Lease Well Nos. 3 and 4 in the Credo, E. (Cisco, Up.) Field, Sterling County, Texas, under increased gas-oil ratio authority, with an unrestricted daily gas limit.

It is further **ORDERED** that all gas overproduction for the Hammon Oil & Refining Company Caldwell -26- Lease Well Nos. 3 and 4 in the Credo, E. (Cisco, Up.) Field, Sterling County, be and is hereby canceled.
