FINAL ORDER APPROVING
THE APPLICATION OF CLAYTON WILLIAMS ENERGY, INC.
FOR AN EXCEPTION TO 16 TAC §3.32
FOR THE HOSEK UNIT, WELL NO. 1
EAGLEVILLE (EAGLEFORD-1) FIELD
WILSON COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on June 01, 2012, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Clayton Williams Energy, Inc. is hereby granted an exception to 16 TAC §3.32 for the Hosek Unit, Well No. 1 (API No. 42-493-32594), in the Eagleville (Eagleford-1) Field, Wilson County, Texas. Clayton Williams Energy, Inc. is authorized to flare up to 135 MCFGPD in its Hosek Unit, Well No. 1, through June 01, 2013. The authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms.

The operator shall file for each well the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, shall file at the same time, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.
