**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF
APACHE CORPORATION
FOR EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32
FOR ITS BIVINS-LIT LEASE, WELL NO. 2802
PAINT RIDGE (CANYON GRANITE WSH) FIELD
OLDHAM COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on February 06, 2012, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and proposal for decision, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Apache Corporation is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for its Bivins-Lit Lease, Well No. 2802 (API No. API No. 42-359-30339) in the Paint Ridge (Canyon Granite Wsh) Field, Oldham County, Texas. Apache Corporation is authorized to flare up to 100 MCF of casinghead gas per day from the Bivins-Lit Lease, Well No. 2802 for a time period no greater than 12 months from the date of this Final Order. The authority is granted provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms.
