**FINAL ORDER
ESTABLISHING THE MOST EFFICIENT RATE OF PRODUCTION
FOR THE SCHINDLER LEASE, WELL NO.1
RIVERSTONE (YEGUA EY-1) FIELD
FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on September 21, 2012, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the most efficient rate of production at the current time for the Horizon Production and Operating, LLC, Schindler Lease, Well No. 1 (API No. 42-157-32519) in the Riverstone (Yegua EY-1) Field, Fort Bend County, Texas, is 375 barrels of oil per day.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction for the Horizon Production and Operating, LLC, Schindler Lease, Well No. 1 (API No. 42-157-32519) in the Riverstone (Yegua EY-1) Field, is hereby canceled.
