**FINAL ORDER  
ESTABLISHING A MOST EFFICIENT RATE ALLOWABLE  
FOR THE BIG THICKET (YEGUA 4950) FIELD,  
TYLER COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on December 13, 2013, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that all wells in the Big Thicket (Yegua 4950) Field, Tyler County, Texas, may be produced under a Maximum Efficient Rate allowable of 130 BOPD. Approval of this Maximum Efficient Rate allowable does not cancel accrued overproduction.
