**FINAL ORDER
ESTABLISHING THE MOST EFFICIENT RATE OF PRODUCTION
FOR EACH WELL IN THE PAM (CHESTER) FIELD
SHACKELFORD COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on January 23, 2013, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the most efficient rate of production at the current time for each well in the Pam (Chester) Field, ID No. 68715 500, Shackelford County, Texas, is established at 150 barrels of oil per day.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction in the Pam (Chester) Field is hereby canceled.
