**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE MOST EFFICIENT RATE OF PRODUCTION AND
INCREASED NET GAS-OIL RATIO AUTHORITY FOR EACH WELL IN THE
ORAN (MARBLE FALLS) FIELD
PALO PINTO COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on December 11, 2013, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the most efficient rate of production at the current time for each well in the Oran (Marble Falls) Field, ID No. 67477 400, Palo Pinto County, Texas, is established at 200 barrels of oil per day. In addition, each well in the Oran (Marble Falls) Field, Palo Pinto County, Texas, is hereby granted permission to produce under increased net gas-oil ratio authority with a casinghead gas limit of 1,200 MCFGPD.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction in the Oran (Marble Falls) Field is hereby canceled.
