**FINAL ORDER  
ESTABLISHING A MOST EFFICIENT RATE ALLOWABLE  
FOR THE CROSBY 8 LEASE, ST. CLAIR (GRANITE WASH) FIELD,  
ROBERTS COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on November 22, 2013, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that all wells in the Crosby 8 Lease (ID No. 08431) in the St. Clair (Granite Wash) Field, Roberts County, Texas, may be produced under a Maximum Efficient Rate allowable of 300 BOPD.

It is further **ORDERED** that all accumulated overproduction for this lease is canceled.
