**FINAL ORDER
CONSOLIDATING THE FARRAR, N. (TRAVIS PEAK) FIELD
INTO THE FARRAR (TRAVIS PEAK) FIELD
LIMESTONE, FREESTONE AND LEON COUNTIES, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on April 20, 2007, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the Farrar, N. (Travis Peak) Field is hereby consolidated into the Farrar (Travis Peak) Field, Limestone, Freestone and Leon Counties, Texas. Form W-1 shall not be required to transfer wells from the Farrar, N. (Travis Peak) Field to the Farrar (Travis Peak) Field.

The allocation formula in the Farrar (Travis Peak) Field will remain suspended. The allocation formula may be reinstated administratively, in accordance with the Commission's rules, if the market demand for gas in the Farrar (Travis Peak) Field drops below 100% of deliverability.
