**FINAL ORDER
CONSOLIDATING THE ROYSTON (CANYON) AND TOLAR (CANYON) FIELDS
INTO THE KEELER-WIMBERLY (CANYON SD.) FIELD AND
APPROVING THE MOST EFFICIENT RATE OF PRODUCTION AND
INCREASED NET GAS-OIL RATIO AUTHORITY
FOR EACH WELL IN THE
KEELER-WIMBERLY (CANYON SD.) FIELD
FISHER COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-number docket heard on January 12, 2009, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required for which service was waived by parties of record; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the Royston (Canyon), Field ID No. 78819 500, and the Tolar (Canyon), Field ID No. 90383 250, Fields, are hereby combined into the Keeler-Wimberly (Canyon SD.) Field, Field ID No. 48422 500.

It is further ordered that the most efficient rate of production at the current time for each well in the Keeler-Wimberly (Canyon SD.) Field is 110 BOPD. It is further ordered that each well in the Keeler-Wimberly (Canyon SD.) Field, Fisher County, Texas, is hereby granted permission to produce under increased net gas-oil ratio authority with a casinghead gas limit of 500 MCFGPD. It is further ordered that each well's oil allowable shall not be penalized unless the above permitted casinghead gas limit is exceeded.

It is further ordered that all overproduction in the Keeler-Wimberly (Canyon SD.) Field is hereby cancelled.

Wells in the subject fields shall be transferred into the Keeler-Wimberly (Canyon SD.) Field without requiring new drilling permits and plats.
