**FINAL ORDER
CONSOLIDATING THE KEYSTONE, SOUTH (WICHITA ALBANY) FIELD
INTO THE KEYSTONE, SOUTH FIELD
AND AMENDING FIELD RULES FOR THE KEYSTONE, SOUTH FIELD
WINKLER COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on April 18, 2001, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the Keystone, South (Wichita Albany) Field is hereby consolidated into the Keystone, South Field. It is further ordered that Rule 1 of the field rules adopted for the Keystone, South Field by Final Order No. 8-93,630, effective October 23, 1989, be amended as set out below.

RULE 1: The entire correlative interval between 6,210 feet and 7,269 feet, as shown on the log of the Keystone Cattle Company Well No. 417, Section 2, Block B-6, P.S.L. Survey, Winkler County, shall be designated as a single reservoir for proration purposes and be designated as the Keystone, South Field.

It is further ordered that the Keystone Cattle Company lease in the Keystone, South (Wichita Albany) Field shall be consolidated with the Keystone Cattle Company lease in the Keystone, South Field. The Entity for Density authority previously granted for the Keystone Cattle Company lease in the Keystone, South Field shall continue in effect after the leases are consolidated.
