**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR AN EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32
FOR THE CURTIS F LEASE WELL NO. 3, CURTIS E LEASE WELL NO. 5,
SCHARBAUER RANCH A LEASE WELL NO. 25,
AND SCHARBAUER RANCH A LEASE WELL NO. 26,
IN THE SPRABERRY (TREND AREA) FIELD, MARTIN COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on August 22, 2013, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and proposal for decision, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Pioneer Natural Res. USA, Inc., is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the following four wells completed in the Spraberry (Trend Area) Field: (1) Curtis F Lease Well No. 3 (API 317-37536) is authorized to flare up to 225 MCFD; (2) Curtis E Lease Well No. 5 (API 317-37560) is authorized to flare up to 175 MCFD; (3) Scharbauer Ranch A Lease Well No. 25 (API 317-37369) is authorized to flare up to 350 MCFD; and (4) Scharbauer Ranch A Lease Well No. 26 (API 317-37407) is authorized to flare up to 140 MCFD. Pioneer is authorized to flare up to the specified amount of gas from these four wells from July 11, 2013 through September 30, 2015. The authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms.

The operator shall file for each well the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, shall file at the same time, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.
