FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF JAMES LAKE MIDSTREAM LLC  
TO CONSTRUCT A SOUR GAS PIPELINE FACILITY,  
JAMES LAKE GATHERING SYSTEM, ANDREWS/GOLDSMITH AREA,  
ANDREWS AND ECTOR COUNTIES, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket reviewed on May 19, 2014, the reviewing examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of James Lake Midstream LLC to construct and operate 28.5 miles of new 6- and 12-inch high pressure hydrogen sulfide gas pipeline in the James Lake Gathering System, Andrews and Ector Counties, Texas, is hereby approved. James Lake Midstream LLC shall comply with all applicable rules and safety standards adopted by the Commission for the construction and operation of hydrogen sulfide gas pipelines.


