**FINAL ORDER  
CONSOLIDATING THE DEW (TRAVIS PEAK, MIDDLE) FIELD  
INTO THE DEW (TRAVIS PEAK) FIELD AND  
ADOPTING FIELD RULES FOR THE DEW (TRAVIS PEAK) FIELD  
FREESTONE COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on October 6, 2014, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the DEW (Travis Peak, Middle) Field, ID No. 24478 380, located in Freestone County, Texas, is hereby combined into the DEW (Travis Peak) Field, ID No. 24478 379.

It is further **ORDERED** by the Commission that the following Field Rules are hereby adopted for the DEW (Travis Peak) Field:

**RULE 1:** The entire correlative interval from 8,899 feet to 10,700 feet, as shown on the log of the William C. Glazener Gas Unit, Well No. 1 (API No. 42-161-30726) in the Durham Avant Survey (A-3) in Freestone County shall be designated as a single reservoir for proration purposes and be designated as the DEW (Travis Peak) Field.
