ORDER NUNC PRO TUNC

APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF KINDER MORGAN PRODUCTION CO. LLC  
TO CONSIDER A SOUR GAS PIPELINE PURSUANT TO RULE 106,  
REINECKE PIPELINE, SACROC UNIT, KELLY-SNYDER FIELD,  
BORDEN AND SCURRY COUNTIES, TEXAS

In conference at its office in Austin, Texas, the Railroad Commission of Texas took up for consideration its Final Order entered on February 24, 2015, the Application of Kinder Morgan Production Company LLC to construct and operate a sour gas pipeline, the Reinecke Pipeline, SACROC Unit, Kelly-Snyder Field, Borden and Scurry Counties. The Commission finds that the Final Order entered February 24, 2015, incorrectly identified the pipeline name.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that the Final Order in Docket No. 8A-0294514 be, and the same is hereby, amended *nunc pro tunc* so that the order contains the correct lateral name and the order now reads as follows:

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of Kinder Morgan Production Company LLC to construct and operate a sour gas pipeline, the Reinecke Pipeline, Sacroc Unit, Kelly-snyder Field, Borden and Scurry Counties, is hereby approved. Kinder Morgan Production Company LLC shall comply with all applicable rules and safety standards adopted by the Commission for the construction and operation of hydrogen sulfide gas pipelines.
