**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF THREE SPAN OIL & GAS, INC.
FOR ENTITY FOR DENSITY AUTHORITY FOR ITS
ADAIR, S.E. (SAN ANDRES) UNIT
ADAIR FIELD, GAINES COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on February 5, 2015, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the Three Span Oil & Gas, Inc. Adair, S.E. (San Andres) Unit, Adair Field shall be treated as an entity-for-density, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. Wells will be drilled in compliance with the applicable lease line spacing rule unless exception is granted after notice and opportunity for hearing.
2. The unit's density shall not exceed that authorized by applicable field rules unless exception is granted after notice and opportunity for hearing. If required by the applicable field rules, operator shall file a Form P-15 and plat for the unit.
3. Except as otherwise provided herein, operator shall comply with all other applicable field rules for the Adair Field.
