**FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF  
COG OPERATING, LLC FOR AN  
EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32 FOR  
VARIOUS WELLS AND FACILITIES, WOLFBONE  
(TREND AREA) FIELD, REEVES COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on May 1, 2015, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and proposal for decision, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that COG Operating, LLC is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for a period of one year, commencing February 26, 2015 and expiring February 25, 2016, for the following tank batteries: the Dubya State 12 Battery (Lease ID No. 08-41620), for a maximum volume of 136 Mcfd; the Lion State Battery (Lease ID No. 08-43578), for a maximum volume of 750 Mcfd; the Tricky Dick Battery (Lease ID No. 08-44801), for a maximum volume of 103 Mcfd; the Trustbuster Battery (Lease ID No. 08-44096), for a maximum volume of 552 Mcfd; the Tycoon C Battery (Lease ID No. pending), for a maximum volume of 1,177 Mcfd; and the Gipper State West (Lease ID No. 08-43845), for a maximum volume of 169 Mcfd. The authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms.

The operator shall file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, shall file at the same time, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee for each tank battery.
