Surveyors go to great lengths to educate themselves in the practice of boundary surveying and are the only qualified professionals that should be making boundary determinations. Additionally, Engineers who promote themselves as surveyors without having a survey license are breaking the rules set by the Texas Board of Professional Land Surveying. Unless an Engineer has proven him/herself as a Registered Professional Land Surveyor, they should not be signing boundary survey plats.

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
