Amend §3.86 and other rules re: UFT fields

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(6) Plat requirements. All Plats required by this section shall be prepared using blue or black ink and shall include a certification by a professional land surveyor registered in accordance with Texas Occupations Code, Chapter 1071, relating to Land Surveyors, or by a registered professional engineer registered in accordance with Texas Occupations Code, Chapter 1001, relating to Professional Engineers.

In accordance with Texas Occupations Code, Chapter 1001, Sec. 1001.003. (a) (2) "Engineering survey" includes any survey activity required to support the sound conception, planning, design, construction, maintenance, or operation of an engineered project. The term does not include the surveying of real property or other activity regulated under Chapter 1071.

I do not think it would be in the best interest of the public to allow a registered professional engineer to certify well plats. While the mineral interests often do not reflect the current surface boundaries, they are still tied to previous tract boundaries that are best determined by a registered professional land surveyor.
