**FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF FORT APACHE ENERGY, INC. FOR AN  
EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32 FOR NORDIN LEASE, WELL NO. 1,  
WILDCAT FIELD, TYLER COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on November 05, 2015, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and proposal for decision, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas Fort Apache Energy, Inc. is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for its Nordin Lease, Well No. 1, Wildcat Field, Tyler County, Texas. Fort Apache is authorized to flare a cumulative total of up to 150 MCFD of casinghead gas from August 01, 2015 through August 01, 2017 from its Augusta Barrow Lease in Ector County, Texas.

The authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms. The operator shall file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet for the Augusta Barrow Lease and shall file, at the same time the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.
