**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING INCREASED NET GAS-OIL RATIO AUTHORITY
FOR THE BRAND JONES LEASE, WELL NO. 2
FIVE HAWKS (GRAY)FIELD
COLEMAN COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on September 23, 2011, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Kornye-Tillman Company is hereby granted permission to produce the Brand Jones Lease, Well No. 2 (API No. 42-083-35875), in the Five Hawks (Gray) Field, Coleman County, Texas, under increased net gas-oil ratio authority with a casinghead gas limit of 175 MCFGPD.

It is further **ORDERED** that the subject well's oil allowable shall not be penalized unless the above permitted casinghead gas limit is exceeded.

It is further **ORDERED** that all accumulated overproduction for the subject well is canceled.
