FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF TEXACO E&P, INC.
TO ESTABLISH AN MER
FOR THE W.B. RHIDDLEHOOVER OIL UNIT NO. 1, WELL NO. 1
CARTHAGE (T.P. 6400 SW) FIELD
PANOLA COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on February 27, 2001, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of Texaco E&P, Inc. is granted such that its W.B. Rhiddlehoover Oil Unit No. 1, Well No. 1, Carthage (T.P. 6400 SW) Field, Panola County, Texas, be and it is hereby allowed to produce up to 400 barrels of oil per day.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction for the Texaco E&P, Inc., W.B. Rhiddlehoover Oil Unit No. 1, Well No. 1 in the Carthage (T.P. 6400 SW) Field, Panola County, be and is hereby canceled.


