FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF EOG RESOURCES, INC.
FOR INCREASED GAS/OIL RATIO AUTHORITY
FOR THE PARKER NO. 1 OIL UNIT WELL NO. 1
CARTHAGE (T.P. 6400 SW) FIELD
PANOLA COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on April 22, 2002, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.


The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ORDERED by the Railroad Commission of Texas that EOG Resources, Inc., be and is hereby granted permission to produce the Parker No. 1 Oil Unit Well No. 1, Carthage (T.P. 6400 SW) Field, Panola County, Texas, under increased gas-oil ratio authority with a daily gas limit of 386 MCF and a daily oil limit of 10 barrels.

It is further ORDERED that all overproduction for the EOG Resources, Inc., Parker No. 1 Oil Unit Well No. 1 in the Carthage (T.P. 6400 SW) Field be and is hereby canceled as of the date of the Final Order.


