THE COMPLAINT OF BENITO R. VILLAREAL ALLEGING THAT GREEN EXPLORATION COMPANY (OPERATOR NO. 330179) DOES NOT HAVE A GOOD FAITH CLAIM TO OPERATE THE VILLAREAL (245754) LEASE, WELL NO. 1, SEJITA, WEST FIELD, DUVAL COUNTY, TEXAS

FINAL ORDER

The Commission finds that after statutory notice the captioned proceedings were heard by an Administrative Law Judge and Technical Examiner on May 2, 2016. An Administrative Law Judge and Technical Examiner have circulated a Proposal for Decision containing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law. Having been duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at Conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas, the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law are hereby adopted and made a part hereof by reference.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the plugging extension for the Villareal (245754) Lease, Well No. 1, Sejita, West Field, located in Duval County, Texas, is **CANCELLED**. Green Exploration Company is hereby **ORDERED** to plug the Villareal (245754) Lease, Well No. 1, Sejita, West Field, located in Duval County, Texas, pursuant to the requirements of Statewide Rule 14(b)(2).

It is further **ORDERED** by the Commission that this order shall not be final and effective until 25 days after the Commission's order is signed, unless the time for filing a motion for rehearing has been extended under Tex. Gov't Code §2001.142, by agreement under Tex. Gov't Code §2001.147, or by written Commission Order issued pursuant to Tex. Gov't Code §2001.146(e). If a timely motion for rehearing of an application is filed by any party at interest, this order shall not become final and effective until such motion is overruled, or if such motion is granted, this order shall be subject to further action by the Commission. Pursuant to Tex. Gov't Code §2001.146(e), the time allotted for Commission action on a motion for rehearing in this case prior to its being overruled by operation of law is hereby extended until 90 days from the date Commission Order is signed.

All pending motions and requests for relief not previously granted or granted herein are denied. Each exception to the Administrative Law Judge's proposal for decision not expressly granted herein is overruled. All requested findings of fact and conclusions of law which are not expressly adopted herein are denied. All pending motions and requests for relief not previously granted or granted herein are denied.
