**ORDER NUNC PRO TUNC**

**APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF  
SILVER CREEK OIL & GAS LLC  
FOR EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32  
CALAMITY JANE LEASE, WELL NO. 1H  
LEVELLAND FIELD  
COCHRAN COUNTY, TEXAS**

In conference at its office in Austin, Texas, the Railroad Commission of Texas took up for consideration its Final Order entered on August 9, 2016, the matter granting Silver Creek Oil & Gas LLC authority to flare casing-head gas from its Calamity Jane Lease, Well No. 1H. The Commission finds that the Final Order entered August 9, 2016, erroneously identified the date of hearing held for Oil & Gas Docket No. 8A-0300423 as June 27, 2015. Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that the Final Order in Oil and Gas Docket No. 8A-0300423 be, and the same is hereby, amended *nunc pro tunc* so that the Final Order correctly states the above-enumerated docket was heard on June 27, 2016.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Silver Creek Oil & Gas LLC is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the Calamity Jane Lease, Well No. 1H, being located in the Levelland Field, Cochran County, Texas. Silver Creek Oil & Gas LLC is authorized to flare up to a cumulative volume of 100 MCF per day of casing-head gas for a period of two years, effective June 8, 2016. This authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms.

The operator shall simultaneously file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet, and the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.
