**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF
CONOCOPHILLIPS COMPANY
FOR EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32
SETTLES CENTRAL, SETTLES NORTH, AND SETTLES WEST BATTERIES
AND THE DORIS COLE LEASE, WELL NO. 14D
HOWARD GLASSCOCK (CONSOLIDATED) FIELD
HOWARD COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numerated docket heard on July 13, 2016, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that ConocoPhillips Company is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the Settles Central Battery (Flare Permit No. 24503), Settles North Battery (Flare Permit No. 24502), Settles West Battery (Flare Permit No. 24501), and Doris Cole Lease, Well No. 14D, being located in the Howard Glasscock (Consolidated) Field, Howard County, Texas. ConocoPhillips Company is authorized to flare up to the maximum volumes of casing-head gas, as listed on Attachment "A" and incorporated herein, effective April 30, 2016 through October 14, 2017. This authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms.

The operator shall simultaneously file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet, and the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.

1. Settles Central Battery (Flare Permit No. 24503) – 170 MCFG per day;
2. Settles North Battery (Flare Permit No. 24502) – 270 MCFG per day;
3. Settles West Battery (Flare Permit No. 24501) – 122 MCFG per day;

ConocoPhillips is also authorized to flare up to the maximum volumes of casing-head gas, as specified above for the Settles Central, Settles North, and/or Settles West Batteries, at a single flare point that serves the Doris Cole Lease, Well No. 14D (API No. 42-227-37544). This authority is granted, provided all applicable Commission rules are followed.
