


APACHE U.S. CNG FLEET VEHICLES



- 2013 CNG-Powered Vehicles = 574 (45%)
- Year-End 2014 Estimated CNG-Powered Vehicles = 650 (51%)
- Long-Term Goal is to Have 80% of U.S. Fleet Powered by CNG

HIGH RATE CNG FILL STATION - WHEELER, TX



- Apache partnered with OsComp Systems to construct a high-rate tube trailer fill station near Wheeler, TX to support our drilling/completion operations
- OsComp will compress, transport and deliver CNG to the well site equipment spreads
- Design fill rates from 10 to 36 DGE/min
- Station will be open for OsComp delivery to other commercial bulk sales customers

APACHE EMPLOYEE CNG VEHICLE INCENTIVE PROGRAM



- **Program Elements:**
- All full-time employees who purchase a new dedicated CNG vehicle or convert a new or used vehicle will receive free CNG for their next \$5,000 of CNG fuel purchases.
- Louisiana and Oklahoma employees will also receive a state income tax credit for 50% of the additional cost of the CNG dedicated or converted vehicle.
- Texas and New Mexico employees will receive this 50% offset from Apache as these states offer no alternative fuel incentives for personal vehicles.
