**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF EXXON MOBIL CORPORATION
FOR FIELDWIDE BALANCING
OF THE EVETTS (PENNSYLVANIAN) FIELD
SMITH COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on October 31, 2008, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of Exxon Mobil Corporation for fieldwide balancing of the Evetts (Pennsylvanian) Field, Winkler and Loving Counties, Texas, is hereby approved, and that all over-production and under-production of allowable for each well in the Evetts (Pennsylvanian) Field is hereby cancelled.
